The Scott Center served

- 206 youth members, ages 5-17
- 103 adults
- 4,335 visitor contacts

Volunteers provided 2,085 service hours

## EDUCATION

- 107 Adults served through the G.E.D. program
- 139 youth served through the After School program

## LIFE SKILLS

- 67 youth served through the tobacco prevention program
- Scott Center facilitated 60 programs/services serving adults and youth
- Family Services Specialist facilitated 4,198 contacts with youth/families providing supportive services

## HEALTH

- 131 service contacts providing adult blood pressure screenings & health education sessions

## EMPLOYMENT

- 41 service contacts were facilitated through the Scott Center's SNAP Workforce Development service center.
- 18 adults served through the Career Readiness program (Monet Adult Learning Center), 10 were hired
